Eight Levels Of Care

Level 1 - Independent Living

Resident requires no personal care

Level 2 - Medication Management

Resident requires control of medication.

Level 3 - Personal Care Management

Resident requires assistance with the activities of daily living.

Level 4- Incontinence Management

Resident requires assistance with bladder and/or bowel incontinence.

Level 5 - Hospice

Resident is terminally ill and under the auspicious of a licensed hospice agency.

Level 6 - Memory Impairment Care

Resident requires monitoring due to issues with Memory Impairment such as wandering and confusion.

Level 7 - Ambulation Management

Resident requests 1 on 1 ambulation four times a week.

Level 8 - Companion Care

One-on-One personal care and supervision.
